

## ABOUT THE GALLERY

New Media Gallery is a contemporary public art gallery in metro Vancouver, operated by the City of New Westminster. Since 2014, we have presented more than 150 extraordinary, award-winning artists in almost 30 exhibitions.

We have an international profile and have become well-known for ground-breaking exhibitions featuring exceptional artists presented in radical exhibition spaces. The gallery space is professionally redesigned and all spaces and walls are rebuilt for every exhibition in consultation with our artists. We aspire to the highest standards of curation, design, installation and artwork care & handling. Our range of high-quality display equipment and technologies is now one of the most comprehensive collections in the region. Ceiling Heights are 14'.

The gallery space is 2000 - 3000 sq ft (186 - 280 m2) depending on the exhibition. We are located in the award-winning Anvil Centre, a contemporary 84,000 sq ft, LEEDS Gold, cultural centre. Our gallery, storage and work areas are all designated Class A within a controlled environmental envelope. We have access to two, full-sized loading docks, preparation and storage rooms, a secure crate storage room, dirty workshop, clean studio rooms and our Creative Lab for art + technology teaching. We have access to a variety of rooms for Artist Talks, plus a 364 seat theatre for larger Talks and Events or events requiring high level acoustics and presentation technologies. There is a full kitchen run by a catering service, with a catered bar for special events. \*See our sample Floor Plans

Executive Director Gordon Duggan and Director-Curator Sarah Joyce are the founding Directors and the Curators for the exhibitions. They have several decades of experience in time-based, electronic media and new media art, working with artists, art professionals and galleries world-wide. We employ an experienced team of Specialist Exhibition Preparators and work with *Denbigh Fine Art* for our shipping +transportation services.

We welcome and encourage artists of all backgrounds to submit their work. All applications will be reviewed and seriously considered.

- We present technology-based work and forms of new media art made, presented and transmitted by technology including time-based media, electronic media, digital media, robotics and biotechnology.
- We present exceptional international, national, regional, including work from metro Vancouver.

- We curate group exhibitions, in-house. We do not present solo exhibitions.
- We do not accept complete exhibition proposals or curatorial proposals. We DO accept links and material connected with individual, artistic practice, preferably from the artist or representative. We accept recommendations.
- Your work must have been created in the last 30 years.
- If you live in metro Vancouver, we will expect you to have visited one of our exhibitions.
- We do not produce works nor can we commission works for the gallery.
- We will present artists with longstanding reputations alongside emerging or mid-career artists.
